

Year 11 – Theatre in Education evaluation

Students were asked the following questions before and after the theatre performance and workshop: (1176 students)	Percentage of students who answered 'Agree' before the performance and workshop:	Percentage of students who answered 'Agree' after the performance and workshop:	What does this suggest?
I will speak up if someone offers me a lift and I suspect they have been drinking or taking drugs.	86%	92%	After the performance, a +6% increase was seen in students becoming more willing to challenge unsafe/illegal driving behaviour in others, reflecting on their own personal safety and concern for others.
I will always switch off my phone or put it in 'do not disturb' before driving.	53%	59%	The performance encouraged students to reflect on phone distraction risks as drivers, showing a +6% increase in this willingness for students to switch off their phone or put it on 'do not disturb'.
I won't drive after 10pm during the first three months of after passing my test.	55%	62%	A +7% increase amongst students demonstrated that after the performance, more agreed to not drive after 10pm after the first three months of passing their test suggested more understanding around the increased risks of driving at this time of night as new drivers.
I will speak up if the driver of the car, I'm in starts using their mobile phone.	71%	81%	After the performance, students' willingness to speak up if their driver starts using a mobile phone rose by +10%, showing an increase in students' confidence to do this if they are a passenger.
