

## Year 7 – Theatre in Education evaluation

<p>Students were asked the following questions before and after the theatre performance and workshop:  (999 students)</p>	<p>Percentage of students who answered 'Agree' before the performance and workshop:</p>	<p>Percentage of students who answered 'Agree' after the performance and workshop:</p>	<p>What does this suggest?</p>
<p>I am willing to pause anything I'm listening to on headphones, such as music or podcasts, when crossing the road.</p>	<p>68%</p>	<p>79%</p>	<p>The +11% positive increase shows that the performance helped to increase willingness amongst one of the main distractions for young people.</p>
<p>I'd be confident in asking my friends to pause what they're listening to when crossing the road.</p>	<p>52%</p>	<p>79%</p>	<p>An increase of +27% after the performance, indicates a strong positive shift in student's willingness to ask their friends to stop their devices while crossing roads.</p>
<p>I am able to make safe choices, even when my friends want me to do something potentially risky.</p>	<p>86%</p>	<p>96% (90% after 6 weeks)</p>	<p>The immediate increase of +10% demonstrates an increase in student's confidence with resisting peer pressure when using the roads, which was sustained at 90% when they were asked six weeks later.</p>
